10. Completed high school, preferably having one year of college or work experience.
11. Pass onsite belay certification.
12. Able to pass a background check.

Responsibilities:

1. Attend staff training and staff meetings.
2. Maintain a safe environment on and around the climbing wall and zipline.
3. Operate according to CPBC ropes policies and procedures.
4. Demonstrate a high value of safety for self and others.
5. Care for the climbing equipment including proper set up and take down.
6. Maintain a positive attitude and confident posture of communication when facilitating.
