## Theme: Come & See What God Has Done

In Psalm 66:5 the psalmist invites us to, "Come and See what God has done; His awesome deeds for mankind" and sing praise to His Glorious name! This year at Women's Retreat we will be reflecting on the work of God the Father, God the Son and God the Holy Spirit in our lives. Come prepared to give Him all the praise, hear stories of encouragement, and have your own time to reflect on what God has done and is doing in your life. This will be a time of joy and celebration!

**Session 3:** Special workshop designed to help you consider what God has done and is doing in your life. (Held in the Dining Hall, 3 p.m.)

**Session 4:** As we understand what God has done for us, we want to look at what God has done in the Church. We will take what we have gleaned from the weekend and consider what our role is in the Church and in our sphere of influence. *Titus 3:4-8*
